

Get online not in line



Congratulations on the purchase of your new vehicle. You may be able to skip the line at the DMV by registering online at www.dmvnv.com. You can transfer your current license plates or get new standard plates by mail. It's quick, easy and, best of all, no lines!

Qualifications

Use the DMV's new online registration if all of the following apply:

- The Dealer, Rebuilder or Lessor's Report of Sale (DRS) lists your valid Nevada Driver's License Number for individuals or a Federal Employer Identification Number for businesses.
- The dealer has issued a valid Emissions Vehicle Inspection Report (when needed).
- You have obtained Nevada insurance on the vehicle from a company licensed in Nevada.
- To transfer plates, your name on the DRS must match the name on the current registration for those plates.

Sorry, but you must register your vehicle in person at a Nevada DMV office if:

- The DRS does not list a Nevada Driver's License number or FEIN, or the number is incorrect.
- Your name is misspelled or you need to change your address.
- You want to use an exemption such as veteran, widow, or tribal.
- You want new personalized or specialty license plates.
- You wish to transfer certain license plate styles such as antique or classic vehicles.
- You wish to use credits other than a credit on license plates being transferred.
- Your vehicle is a motor home.
- Your physical address on your Nevada DLN, or on file with the DMV, is in Clark or Washoe County and you want to base your vehicle in a different county.
- You currently have a bad debt, Insurance Verification sanction, or parking tickets.
- The gross vehicle weight rating of the vehicle is 26,001 pounds or more.
- The unladen weight of the trailer is 10,000 pounds or more.

How It Works

- Have your DRS and Nevada Evidence of Insurance card ready, log on to www.dmvnv.com and click *Online Vehicle Registration*. You may pay registration fees by e-check, debit or credit card.
- If you are transferring plates, any credit on your existing registration will be applied to the new registration. You may transfer plates up to 18 months after they have expired.
- Your vehicle will be registered immediately upon successful completion. If transferring plates, the registration on your old vehicle is immediately surrendered.
- A temporary permit prints with your receipt. Tape this in the lower right-hand corner of the windshield and keep the receipt in the vehicle.
- Your Registration Certificate and Validation Decal will arrive at the address listed on the DRS in four to seven days.
- If you are receiving new plates, they will arrive separately in seven to 10 days.
