## EMISSION INSPECTOR INFORMATION

“Approved inspector” defined. “Approved inspector” means a person licensed by the Department of Motor Vehicles to inspect motor vehicles and devices for the control of pollution for an authorized station or authorized inspection station. NRS 445B.705

1. Certificate of Employment (DS236) completed and signed by a principal or authorized representative of a licensed Nevada Emission Station.
2. Personal History Questionnaire (DS242) completed by the applicant.
3. Authorization for Release of Information (DS254). Release must be notarized or signature witnessed by an authorized DMV representative.
4. Child Support Information (DS268) completed and signed by the applicant.
5. Licensee Acknowledgement (DS308).
6. One photograph of applicant. Photo must be full face, shoulders and above, no sunglasses or hats.
7. License fee of \$25 for first location, \$10 for each additional location.
8. Class 1 and Class 2 inspectors must comply with provisions of NAC 445B.485 in areas of training, qualifications, experience, and pass an examination administered by the Department.
