



MOTOR CARRIER DIVISION

With the passage of Assembly Bill (AB) 336 during the 2013 legislative session, effective January 1, 2015, registrants with commercial semi and full trailers are eligible for permanent trailer registration(s). Permanent trailer registrations are valid and do not expire until the owner of the trailer transfers ownership or cancels and surrenders the license plate. In addition to the \$111.00 fee for permanent trailer registration, there is also a \$4.50 plate fee. All permanent trailer registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferrable.

The Department of Motor Vehicles, Motor Carrier Division will begin full implementation of the permanent commercial trailer registration beginning with the registration period of January 1, 2015 – December 31, 2015.

Existing trailer registrations can be switched to permanent trailer registrations beginning with the January – December 2015 renewals. On your renewal paperwork, simply indicate which trailers are going to be changed and those trailers will be set up on a new permanent trailer fleet. Once the registration fees have been paid and the new plates issued, the old trailer plates should be returned to a Motor Carrier office.

Please Note: Pursuant to NRS 482.205, trailers based in Nevada should be registered in Nevada.

NRS 482.205 Registration required for certain vehicles. Except as otherwise provided in this chapter and [NRS 706.188](#), every owner of a motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer intended to be operated upon any highway in this State shall, before the motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer can be operated, apply to the Department or a registered dealer for and obtain the registration thereof.
