Nevada LIVE status updates:

Bernie – DMV:

- The questions and answers from November and Guidelines should be posted on the web by next week.
- The regulations are due from LCB by December 2, 2009. The regulation hearing was scheduled for December 14th but had to be cancelled because the hearing cannot be scheduled until after the department receives LCB's revisions.

Motor Vehicle Information Technology (MVIT) updates:

Mani – DMV:

- We are making progress with the web service and SFTP. Within the next 2 weeks we will be in touch with some of the insurance companies to send us the test file of the Book of Business.

Question and Answer Period:

Task Force Representative:

- Are the codes V and VS for Vehicle Specific interchangeable?

Doreen Rigsby – DMV:

- Effective February we are using 2 indicators. V for vehicle and N for non-vehicle.

Task Force Representative:

- Can the creation date be at the end of the header?

Doreen Rigsby – DMV

- The end date cannot be later than the creation date. We are asking for the term date in the Book of Business.

Kristie – Nationwide:

- On the effective dates and termination dates will you be looking for 6 month terms and 1 year terms?

Doreen Rigsby – DMV

- We won't be matching that. We will be looking for what the insurance company gives us as the term date.

Mani – DMV:

- We are going to have basic validations. Your termination date cannot be before the policy start date. We trust the company will put in the correct termination date in the termination date field.

Bill Schrader – American Family Insurance:

- We are going to fall under the Group B category. Under that category does Nevada require a key exchange?

Doreen Rigsby – DMV:

- When we receive the admin form we will contact the person you have listed as your Administrator and the IT person. We will send an additional form called an SSH form and that is where you'll put that information.

Task Force Representative:

- Will we get an error file with SFTP?

Mani – DMV:

- Yes, you will get an error file.

Task Force Representative:

- How will the initial Book of Business load? Will you use a matching schema or are you building your records from scratch?

Mani – DMV:

- We are using matching schemas that Nevada DMV currently uses.

Task Force Representative:

- How long will we be able to use SFTP before we're required to change to web services?

Mani – DMV: We want you to convert to web services before the end of 2010.

Task Force Representative:

- Are the specifics for how the data will be formatted for SFTP – Group B listed in the Group B User Guide?

Bernadette Nieto – DMV:

- Yes. It is already there.

Nationwide Representative:

- On the termination transaction it states that the date must be equal to or greater than the created date. We have instances where we back date a cancellation and that will not be possible.

Bernadette Nieto – DMV:

- This was a typo error. It should read "less than."
