Nevada LIVE status updates:

Bernadette Nieto – DMV:

- Our programmers have been working with the Group A companies. We are still having issues with the WSDL and certificates. On the Nevada LIVE website we have the IICMVA Guidelines that specify the WSDL and SOAP message we need. If your WSDL/SOAP message does not match the IICMVA requirements we are going to get errors. The certificate requirement is also on the web. If you are struggling with any of these issues please review the documents. So far, everything is going as planned on the business side.
- The regulation hearing has been scheduled for March 9th at 12:45 p.m. The hearing will be held at LCB in Carson City and videoconferenced to the Sawyer Building in Las Vegas. The notice is posted at the DMV offices and area libraries and also on the web. Everyone is welcome to attend the hearing, or if you would like, you may submit written comments or questions to Bernadette Nieto at bnieto@dmv.nv.gov
- Have your production web site available beginning March 6, 2010. We will begin stress, load and various other tests to your production site until we go live. This information will be posted on the Nevada LIVE web page.

Elena Aherns – Division of Insurance:

- Evidence of Insurance Cards regulation workshop will be held March 11th and the hearing March 22nd in Carson City and Las Vegas. You may find more information on the Division of Insurance web site.

Motor Vehicle Information Technology (MVIT) Updates:

Mani – DMV:

- While testing with the Group A insurance companies one of the key issues we are encountering is if we test today and the test is successful the next time we test with the company it doesn't work. We have an

automatic process that continuously checks the insurance company records. We are requesting from the insurance companies that once you test with us and the testing is successful we want you to continue to maintain and keep your test site running until we go live.

- All testing has to be completed by March 5, 2010. If you have not tested by March 5th you will be out of compliance.
- Book of Business cannot be older than March 5th.

Task Force Participant:

- When do we submit our Book of Business?

Bernadette Nieto – DMV:

- You will submit the Book of Business according to your scheduled date. This begins the week of March 8th. The Book of Business cannot be older than March 5th.

Task Force Participant:

- Could you elaborate on the stress and load tests?

Mani – DMV:

- We will run the stress and load tests March 6, from 10:00-11:00 a.m. and 3:00-4:00 p.m., and March 7, from 10:00-11:00 a.m. and 3:00-4:00 p.m. After that, the automated process will check starting around 6:00 p.m. everyday until we go live.

Task Force Participant:

- When will Group C companies be notified to start testing?

Bernadette Nieto – DMV:

- We hope to finalize our programming for Group C companies this week and next week we will notify you of your user i.d, password and instructions on how to log in and do testing. On March 15th we will move you into production.

Arielle Brath – Sentry Insurance:

- With the Book of Business, it states in the guidelines that there is a 7-day turn around time for error corrections. Can that time be extended?

Bernadette Nieto – DMV:

- The problem that will occur if we don't get the corrections right away, your customers will show in our system as not having active insurance and they will get a postcard.

Task Force Participant:

- If we are a Group B company and we want to move to Group A, do we notify you when we are ready?

Bernadette Nieto – DMV:

- Yes, but we will not move anybody until after April 1, 2010.

Important Reminder:

- Beginning March 6, 2010, we will begin hitting your production websites. Any insurance company that has not successfully tested with us by March 5th will be reported to DOI for compliance issues. March 15th is our go live date and we will not have anyone hold us back from achieving this date.
