Nevada LIVE status updates:

- Survey: There have been 70 responses as of Tuesday, February 24, 2009. The survey will be removed from the web next Monday morning.
- Nevada LIVE web page: The meeting agendas and minutes are being posted to the NV LIVE website. The address is www.dmvnv.com/nvlive.htm.
- Draft User Requirements: The draft should be out for review in the next week.
 - Question: Will it be on the website? It will be posted on the website the week after.

Motor Vehicle Information Technology (MVIT) updates:

- Security Certificates: Getting closer to having the web server tested by a couple of companies. Working out some issues and hope to have them completed by the next conference call.
- 2-D Barcodes: Comments have not been received from the Division of Insurance on the 2-D barcode draft.
- Pilot Program: By the end of the year we will be piloting with a few insurance companies, but will be piloting with them one at a time before we go live.

Question and Answer Period:

- To the insurance companies that already have web services: What is the size of the company and what was the cost to implement web services?
 - No information available, so Terri asked that the insurance companies get back to her by email.
- Is the web services program going to replace the current system and be mandatory for the insurance companies?
 - Yes, that is our intent. It will eliminate the current antiquated tape system.
- Will there be exceptions for smaller volume insurance companies?
 - Yes, currently looking at companies with 500 or fewer vehicles that they would have an alternative reporting method.

- What is timeline for Ace American to implement web services?
 - In early stages and do not have timeline. Mani asked if they could give an update in the next conference call.
- Will commercial vehicles be included in the new program?
 - Not in the beginning phases, but it will be looked at later. Commercial vehicles are defined by the DMV as a vehicle in excess of 26,000 lbs. This will be outlined in the user requirements.
- Follow up to George Cooper's email of February 20:
 - We will be specifying data elements user requirement document and we will address the operator policy issue.
- Will the full book of business be required with the web services program?
 - Yes, we will require the full book of business for active policies when we first go live. After that the current design does not require a full book of business at any other time.
- How will the full book of business be sent?
 - Looking into using FTP for first time full book of business. The user requirements will have this information in it when released.
