Nevada LIVE status updates:

- Survey Results: Mailed 862 surveys and letter notifications and received responses from 79 insurance companies. Most responses were from companies that do not sell liability auto insurance in Nevada. The results were insignificant due to the lack of responses. The insurance companies that responded will be posted on the DMV web site. The address is www.dmvnv.com/nvlive.htm.
- Elena Ahrens with Division of Insurance will check with the Insurance Commissioner on getting the regulatory agency involved in the survey.
 - Question: What information was requested on the survey?
 - What companies have web services?
 - What companies write operator policies?
 - What companies write fleet policies?
 - Contact names
- Insurance User Requirements: It will be at least another three to four weeks before the document will be placed on the web. The document will be in draft form so comments can be entered.
- Commercially insured vehicles: Our plan is to address this issue in August.

Motor Vehicle Information Technology (MVIT) Update:

- Security Certificates: Software installation and mainframe to query the insurance company web services is complete. Currently writing a test program to query a couple of insurance companies to test the connectivity.
- 2-D Barcodes on proof of insurance cards: A question was posed to Elena on how we can accomplish putting the barcodes on the insurance cards. Elena stated she has reviewed the IICMVA standards and had questions for the Task Force.

- Questions from Elena:
 - What states currently use the IICMVA standards? None at this time. New York is the only state that mandates a barcode and they use their own standards.
 - Are there any other states that are contemplating using the IICMVA standards? There are 3 – 4 states. The standard is endorsed by AAMVA.
 - Of the 3 – 4 states contemplating using the standards how far have they gone and have they run into any road blocks? It's only conversational at this time.
 - What's the purpose of optional fields? The state can add state-specific data.

Question and Answer Period:

- Will the full book of business have only personal auto or will commercial also be included.
 - Will discuss at next meeting.
- Are we still planning on an implementation date for the end of the year?
 - Yes
- What are the download options for insurance companies?
 - We are working on this. Best option would be web services.

Department of Motor Vehicles will meet with Elena on 2-D barcodes.
