We are currently researching and working on the responses to your questions. We are hoping to have the document posted by the beginning of next week as well as the User Requirements for your review. **Motor Vehicle Information Technology (MVIT) updates:**

- Working on web service connectivity testing with State Farm. We are making progress and are working on an issue with the security certificate.

**Question and Answer Period:**

Kristen - Foremost Insurance:

- We have antique vehicle policies that do not have a VIN or owners name. For the initial load of business do you want us to send the policies that have no driver or VIN?

To help us answer this question Jerry will send Doreen the number of antique vehicle policies. This issue will be discussed at a future meeting.

Kristen – Foremost Insurance:

- You are requesting that we match by registered owner's name. We find this to be an unfortunate way to match. Is the registered owner's name a requirement?

Terri - DMV

- We will have the answer in the revised document.

Sandy – Hartford

- Is there any way to get a sample of the SOAP message?

Mani – DMV

- You can find a sample in the IICMVA manual.

Jerry – Foremost

- What is the 550 format?

Mani – DMV

- It's the current format that companies are using to report to the Nevada DMV.

Chad Sailer – State Farm Insurance

- The requirement specified by IICMVA is the 300 format which is what we coded our book of business to.

Mani – DMV

- We will work individually with the insurance companies that are using the 300 format. Most insurance companies are using the 550 format and there a lot of issues converting to the 300 format. We felt it was in the best interest of the insurance companies to have the book of business in the 550 format.

Chad Sailer – State Farm Insurance

- Are you willing to accept a text file from State Farm or Farmers?

Mani – DMV

- Not at this time.

- When is the book of business due?

Mani – DMV

- We will work with the individual companies on this. We do not want everyone sending at the same time. It will be toward the end of this year or early part of 2010.

Sandy – Hartford

- When will you be able to work with other carriers or partners on web service connectivity?

Mani – DMV

- Once the initial test with State Farm goes through we will then work with the individual companies a few weeks after that.
