

The Office of the Governor is seeking applicants interested in serving on the Commission on Off-Highway Vehicles. The Commission will consist of 11 members appointed by the Governor to work to create and promote responsible off-highway vehicle recreation in Nevada in accordance with Senate Bill 394 of the 2009 Legislative session. Vacancies currently exist for the following:

1. an authorized dealer.
2. a representative of an organization that represents persons who use off-highway vehicles to access areas to participate in recreational activities for off-highway vehicles that do not primarily involve off-highway vehicles.
3. One member to represent each of the following users and who reside in Nevada and have participated in recreational activities for at least five years and have been recommended by a profit or non-profit corporation, association or organization of off-highway vehicles; and
 - Own or operate all-terrain motorcycles
 - Own or operate snowmobiles
 - Own or operate, and participate in the racing of off-highway motorcycles

After the initial terms, each member of the Commission serves for a term of three years.
